# Sample Interview Questions

## **1. Tell us about your debut novel, *Finding Forevermore*. What inspired this story?**

**Kelly Jo Wilson:** *Finding Forevermore* was inspired by my love for stories that dig deep into the human experience—how people heal, how they grow, and how love, faith, and grace can transform lives. Raven's journey of searching for her father and discovering the truth about her past is a reflection of the spiritual journey many of us go through, learning to trust God even when we've been hurt. It was important for me to write a story that blends the challenges of real life with the hope that comes from faith, and Raven and Cole's paths felt like the perfect way to tell that story.

## **2. As a Christian author, how does your faith influence your writing?**

**Kelly Jo Wilson:** Jesus is at the heart of everything I write. For me, it's about showing characters who struggle—like we all do—but who find strength and hope through God's grace. In *Finding Forevermore*, both Raven and Cole are broken in different ways, and they have to learn to let go of their fears and trust in God's plan for their lives. I think that mirrors the walk of faith we all experience, and it's something I hope readers can resonate with.

## **3. Raven and Cole both deal with personal pain—Raven with abandonment and Cole with PTSD and guilt. How did you approach writing these deep emotional struggles?**

**Kelly Jo Wilson:** I wanted to make sure their struggles felt real and relatable. For Raven, her fear of abandonment and rejection and her journey to find her father reflect a deep emotional pain many people experience. Cole's physical injuries, PTSD, and survivor's guilt are also issues that a lot of people struggle with, especially those who have served in the military. I did a lot of research to ensure I was handling Cole's PTSD with the respect and authenticity it deserves. Both characters have to confront their pain and lean on each other—and their faith—to heal, and I think that's something we all need to do in our own lives.

## **4. What do you hope readers take away from *Finding Forevermore*?**

**Kelly Jo Wilson:** I hope readers walk away with a sense of hope and encouragement. Both Raven and Cole have to learn that they are worthy of love and that their pasts don't define them. My prayer is that readers see themselves in these characters and understand that no matter what they've been through, God's love is constant. There's always redemption and healing available if we're willing to trust Him.
